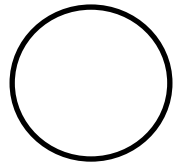

c. I had before studied for the exam I realized it was cancelled.

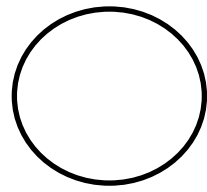
8- I had closed my eyes. I fell asleep. (**Begin with ... Hardly**)
