Some people say you should not judge a book by its cover, but unfortunately, that is exactly what many people do. Personally, I do not see any harm in judging a book by its cover. If all books looked the same, and gave us no information about the author, surely it would be harder to choose.

Recently I took part in a reading experiment. I was one of two hundred people who received a book to read within ten days. The book had no cover, title, or the author's name.
