In addition, other special types of memories may recall smell, taste, touch, sound, and **performing** physical movements.

We have two ways of storing any of these memories; our short-term memory and long-term memory. Our-short term memory stores different items for a short period of time. Older people in fact have a much better long-term memory than short-term because long-term memory gets better with age. <u>They</u> may forget what they have done only a few hours ago, but have the clearest remembrance of when they were very young.

You might assume that the more we remember the better. How wonderful never to forget anything! But in fact, we need to forget. If we remembered all our unhappy times, we would become mentally ill. Indeed, a few people do become ill because of this. A case is recorded of one man whose memories were so strong that he sometimes did not know whether he was really experiencing something, such as looking at an alarm clock in the morning or crossing the road, or just remembering having done it in the past.


