When you find a new word in a comprehension passage, it is not a good way to think directly of using the dictionary all the time to know its meaning. It is better for you to try first to understand the main idea of the passage and guess its meaning. Second, don't forget to look at the opposite of the word and try to remember it. If these two ways are not helpful, get the dictionary then and look it up. You will find different meanings for one word. You can use the **appropriate** meaning which will allow you to understand these words through the text.

Some books have a mini-dictionary at their backs. The electronic dictionaries are the latest. They have more advantages than the printed ones because they are easy to download and carry, you can take them with you everywhere and listen clearly to the correct way of pronouncing words. Fortunately, smart phones can be supplied with different dictionary applications to make them more attractive specially for those who do not prefer to use paper dictionaries.

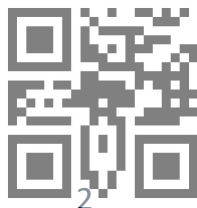

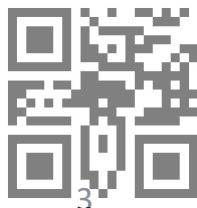

Like people, other living creatures can communicate. However, animal communication is sometimes sound communication and sometimes action communication.

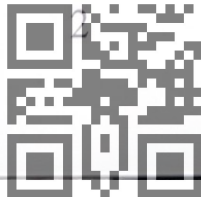
